
## 1 - ANALYSIS OF BRAZILIAN EXPORTS OF HIDES AND SKINS

MARCH 2020

The Hides and Skins Exports released by SECEX (Foreign Trade Secretariat), for the month of March 2020, registered the amount of US\$ 97.2 million, down 18.3% year-on-year, when total exports were US\$ 118.9 million, and also lower 0.9% compared to February, when amount was US\$ 98.1 million.

Considering exports in square meters, during March were shipped 15.8 million, down 13.2% year-on-year, and lower 1.7% than February, when total was 16.1 million.


Below is the profile of 1Q 2020 exports:



These are the variations of the Brazilian exports of bovine leather during 1Q of 2020, year-on-year:

- Salted hides down 34.0% (before -51.3%) in value, but higher 34.3% (+13.8%) in weight;
- Wet Blue declined 37.3% (-34.2%) in value and 23.1% (-18.5%) in area;
- Split WB higher 11.3% (+20.6%) in value and 12.2% (+23.2%) in area;
- Crust was higher 9.1% (+9.3%) in value and 17.1% (+20.4%) in area;
- Finished leather lower 9.8% (-8.7%) in value, but higher 1.9% (+3.9%) in area.

Below are the 2020 destinations:




These are 2020 1Q highlights for the three main destinations for Brazilian leather:

- China, with share of 23.5% in value and 30.5% in area, falling 14.4% in traded area (-6.7% in Feb) and also -18.4% in value (-11.6%);
- US, with share of 20.9% in value and 11.4% in area, has increased 22.0% in area (+15.9%) and 10.9% in value (+3.1%);
- Italy, with share of 15.4% in value and 19.2% in area, has reduction of 17.1% in traded area (-9.2%), and also down 31.7% considering value (-27.6%).

Among the main destinations, the USA remains the only one to show improvements in imported volumes and values. China and Italy are worsening performance every month.

As an analysis of other countries considered important players in the leather trade, we highlight the following: Vietnam, in 4<sup>th</sup> place in the ranking (6.3% value share), shows increase of 42.3% in area but fall of 9.7% in value; Hong Kong, with share of 4.6% in value, is keeping significant growth of 51.2% in area, but down 25.3% in value (-17.2%); Germany, back to 5<sup>th</sup> place, now with share of 4.6%, shows drop of 25.1% (-19.5%) in value and 12.5% in area; and, finally, Mexico, with share of 4.4%, continues with increase of 66.6% (+92.0%) in area and +52.3% in value (+67.8%). It is important to highlight exports to Macau, which will become a destination in 2020 for Brazilian leather, being an alternative entry into mainland China, given the problems presented by Hong Kong in recent years.

Some highlights considering exporting states:

- Among the ten states with largest exports in the country, Minas Gerais, which until February showed recovery in value, now has stable indexes, with only +0.6%. All others show falls. If we consider the traded area, four of them have a positive performance in the 1Q, being: Mato Grosso do Sul (+17.3%), Bahia (+13.6%), Minas Gerais (+8.3%), and Pará (+0.6%);

- Still in the top ten, largest drops in value were: Ceará, with -28.1% (before -37.2%); Goiás, with -24.7% (-24.0%); Pará, with -22.9% (-9.2%); Bahia, with -18.6% (-5.1%); Santa Catarina, with -18.5% (-14.0%); and Paraná, with -17.1% (-1.2%);

- Despite fall in value and area, Rio Grande do Sul remains leader in shipments, with share of 26.8% and 21.8%, respectively. Paraná continues in second considering value, with share of 15.1%, but now in fourth in volume, with 12.8%; São Paulo remains in third place, with a share value of 14.4%, and returns to second place in area, with 16.1%. Goiás, therefore, it is in fourth place in value and third in area.

- In this 1Q, the highlight in increasing value and exported area goes to Rondônia, which passes Rio de Janeiro and occupies the 12<sup>th</sup> position, with an increase of 319.4% in value and 586.7% in area.



The volumes exported in March are beginning to show a worrying scenario, where the stability that until then was apparent, starts to give rise to stronger falls, mainly in Wet Blue leathers. Split WB still maintains growth in value and volume in the quarter, however in March it had the first falls in both items. The growth in volume of finished and semi-finished leathers, in the latter also in terms of value, started to decrease or even negate, having a strong impact on total exports. The daily average of exports decreased, but the greater number of working days in March favored the total. With the fall of WB, finished leather started to recover its share in value and volume, showing that the stability of exports at this stage still tends to be more secure. The criteria of low raw material prices and a valued US dollar are no longer determinants to maintain volumes. Everything becomes a matter of demand. The coming months will be decisive in the result of the year, where tanneries and manufacturing are already feeling the strong impacts of the pandemic.




