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1 - ANALYSIS OF BRAZILIAN EXPORTS OF HIDES AND SKINS


JUNE 2021

The Hides and Skins Exports released by SECEX (Foreign Trade Secretariat) of the Ministry of Economy, for the month of June 2021, amounted to US\$ 119.0 million, a sharp increase of 146.1% year-on-year, when US\$ 48.4 million worth was exported. Compared to the previous month, reflects a drop of 0.2%, when total was US\$ 119.3 million.

Considering exports in square meters, during June were shipped 14.3 million, 64.3% higher year-on-year, however down 6.0% compared to the previous month, when total was 15.1 million.

The first half of the year ended with a total of US\$ 679.5 million, 51.0% above the same period in 2020, and also an increase of 17.4% in traded area, with 91.4 million square meters.


Below is the profile of 2021's bovine exports:



These are the variations of the Brazilian exports of bovine leather during the 1H of 2021, year-on-year:

- Salted hides higher 49.4% (previous +82.0%) in value, but now a drop of 38.2% (previous -15.1%) in weight;
- Wet Blue growing 64.7% (+57.0%) in value, but still -12.0% (-12.6%) in area;
- Split WB higher 44.9% (+33.3%) in value and 37.3% (+28.5%) in area;
- Crust growing 47.2% (+41.2%) in value and also 25.2% (+21.5%) in area;
- Finished leather up 46.7% (+32.8%) in value, and also +32.2% (+21.1%) in area.

Below are the 2021 destinations:



Some highlights of results for 2021 of the three main destinations for Brazilian leather:

- China (without HK) keeps share of 28.7% (previous 28.7%) in value and 34.2% (previous 33.7%) in area, with a monetary increase of 70.4% (+61.4%), and also up 25.1% (+19.4%) in area;
- Italy, with share of 15.9 (16.3%) in value and 15.7% (16.3%) in area, with an increase of 57.5% (+50.3%) in value, but still down 3.2% (-2.5%) in area;
- United States, keeping share of 14.6% (14.6%) in value and 9.1% (9.0%) in area, shows a monetary grow of 24.4% (+11.1%) and also up 16.4% (+3.5%) in area.

With the significant result of exports in June 2021 compared to the month with the greatest impact of the pandemic in 2020, most countries improved their results in the purchase of Brazilian leather, accumulating important growth for the sector. The movement to increase the share of China and the United States in Brazilian exports has evolved even more now. Italy, however, appears with growth in value, but decreasing in volume, compared to the result until the month of May, showing clear signs of a price recovery in the main type of leather exported by Brazil to the Italians, which is wet blue, with 63.7% of share.

India continues to be the exception among the thirty main destinations for Brazilian leather, with a drop in value over the 1H of 2020. The other 29 countries show growth, with the vast majority also showing improvements in volumes. The growth highlights in both aspects are: Spain, with an increase of 207.5% in value, and also 529.0% in area; Argentina, with +172.3% in value and +71.0% in area; South Korea, with an increase of 168.3% in value and also 86.4% in area; and Switzerland, which this year started importing Brazilian leather again.

Some highlights considering exporting states:

- The ten largest exporting states continue to improve their monetary growth rates, with the following highlights: Minas Gerais, with +99.1% (previously +59.7%); Ceará, with +75.3% (previously +64.3%); Paraná, with +72.8% (+54.7%); São Paulo, +64.6% (+51.8%); and Rio Grande do Sul, +60.9% (+49.8%);
- Considering the volume exported, Mato Grosso do Sul and Pará still show decreases in weight (-38.2% and -27.1%) and area (-31.1% and -27.1%), respectively. Bahia presents a small drop only in area, of -4.5%, with an increase in weight, with +1.2%;
- The four largest state exporters continue to be Rio Grande do Sul (29.6% share in value), São Paulo (16.0%), Paraná (14.6%) and Goiás (13.4%). In area, Paraná (15.5%) changes position with São Paulo (15.2%), appearing in second place. Finally, in weight, São Paulo is in fourth place (13.2%), with Paraná in second (17.2%) and Goiás in third (15.5%).

If we consider only the general numbers of Brazilian exports for the first half, we have satisfactory results and expressive growth over the same period in 2020. However, we have to consider the weak base of the most severe period of the pandemic, together with record prices for the main raw material and chemicals, in addition to undervalued exchange rates and restricted transport, logistics and supply situations facing very high freight rates. The most appropriate situation would be to consider this year's exports compared to the same period in 2019, where the growth in value was 7.4% and there were falls in area (-3.6%) and weight (-12.8%) .

Regarding the share of leather types in the traded area, the improvement of Finished Leather is evident, which ended 2019 with a lower share than Wet Blue (44.2% against 48.4% for WB), which remained below in 2020, but in 2021 it shows recovery and now it has 53.3%, against 36.4% for the WB. Semi-finished leather, which in 2019 had a 7.5% share, increased to 8.6% in 2020 and now has 10.2%.



The second half of the sector is going through uncertainties, such as the price situation for hides, slaughter levels, and, above all, the behavior of demand. Regarding the availability of hides, Europe, Australia and most countries in South America show reductions in slaughter, while North America shows growth. In terms of demand, there are now stability in Europe, while Asia proves to be supplied with raw material, with acquisitions stable or even falling. Among the segments, adjustments were registered in the purchase of leather for the furniture upholstery sector, with an increase in the production of leather for shoes and a recovery in automotive production. In September, when the northern hemisphere returns from vacation, the market should show a clearer course for exporters. -




