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## 1 - ANALYSIS OF BRAZILIAN EXPORTS OF HIDES AND SKINS


JULY 2020

The Hides and Skins Exports released by SECEX (Foreign Trade Secretariat), for the month of July 2020, registered the amount of US\$ 66.2 million, down 23.1% year-on-year, when total exports were US\$ 86.1 million, however with a sharp increase of 36.8% compared to June, when amount was US\$ 48.4 million.

Considering exports in square meters, during July were shipped 12.5 million, down 8.1% year-on-year, but higher 44.1% than June, when total was 8.7 million.

The first seven months of 2020 ended with a total of US\$ 516.6 million, 28.2% less compared to the same period of 2019, and also 16.7% below in trade area, with 90.3 million square meters.


Below is the profile of 2020's bovine exports till July:



These are the variations of the Brazilian exports of bovine leather during 2020 till July, year-on-year:

- Salted hides higher 32.0% (previous +14.9%) in value, and also +171.8% (+131.5%) in weight;
- Wet Blue declined 32.6% (-37.2%) in value and 18.1% (-24.3%) in area;
- Split WB down 7.2% (-4.5%) in value and also down 7.1% (-4.7%) in area;
- Crust with value down 5.1% (-5.4%), but still higher 3.3% (+4.3%) in area;
- Finished leather lower 31.4% (-30.5%) in value and also down 23.7% (-21.9%) in area.

Below are the 2020 destinations:




These are highlights of the first seven months of 2020 for the three main destinations for Brazilian leather:

- China, with share of 26.5% (previous 25.4%) in value and 33.8% (32.1%) in area, down 12.7% (-18.4%) in traded area and also -19.7% (-23.6%) in value;
- US, with share of 18.0% (17.7%) in value and 9.3% (9.2%) in area, down 16.6% (-15.3%) in area and -22.9% (-22.2%) in value;
- Italy, with share of 14.8% (15.3%) in value and 18.4% (19.1%) in area, has reduction of 22.9% (-26.4%) in traded area, and also down 38.4% (-40.7%) considering value.

Although the three main destinations still show declines y-o-y, both in value and in volume, with the improvement of exports compared to June the situation changed direction in both China and Italy. Even though modest, the reactions in these two countries result in improvements in the indexes compared to the previous period. The USA improved the share, but continue to worsen the indexes. On the other hand, Italy worsened the share, but as the previous falls were higher than the average, it showed improvement in the indexes compared to the results till June.

As an analysis of other countries considered important players in the leather trade, we highlight the following: Vietnam, in 4<sup>th</sup> place in the ranking (6.3% value share), shows increase of 0.7% (+12.5%) in area, but fall of 28.0% (-22.6%) in value; Hong Kong, with share of 4.6% in value, is keeping growth of 17.3% (+14.5%) in area, but down 38.4% (-39.4%) in value; Mexico, keeping share of 4.0% in value, now shows decrease of 7.3% (+1.5%) in area, also down 12.9% (-5.4%) in value; and Germany, with share of 3.9% in value, show a decline of 41.8% (-36.5%) in area, and also down 48.2% (-44.4%) in value. Among the TOP30 destinations, positive exports' highlights go to Poland (+146.8% in value and +252.6% in area), to Lithuania (+56.8% in value and +43.8% in area), to Turkey (+30.7% in value and +11.9% in area), and to British Virgin Islands (+67.8% in value and +35.6% in area).

Some highlights considering exporting states:

- TOP10 exporting states continue with negative rates in values, with only two presenting positive rates in the traded area, being: Mato Grosso do Sul (+3.7%) and Bahia (+1.0%);
- Trend inversions also occurred in most states, with improvements in value criteria over the previous period. Considering TOP10 states, São Paulo and Minas Gerais worsened indexes. The largest drops are: Ceará, with -51.8% (previous -52.1%); São Paulo, with -35.2% (-34.8%); Paraná, with -31.0% (-31.4%); Minas Gerais, with -28.6% (-20.4%); Santa Catarina, with -28.6% (-31.5%); Pará, with -27.8% (-37.8%); and Goiás, with -27.7% (-29.8%);
- Leader in exports remains Rio Grande do Sul, including improving its share. Now its share is 28.0% (previous 27.8%) in value and 22.9% (22.7%) in area. São Paulo continues in second place in value (share of 14.6%), and fourth in area (share of 12.2%); Goiás is third in value and area, improving to 14.3% (14.2%) in value and keeping 14.3% in area; and Paraná standing in fourth position in value, with a share of 12.7%, and keeping also second place in area, with 15.6% (15.4%);
- The most expressive growths among all states are: Acre, with +478.6% in value and +791.5% in area, and Rondônia, showing +61.1% in value and +121.9% in area.

The recovery of July over the previous month is still incipient, but it shows an important reaction of the sector in face of a still weak and stagnant market situation in most countries. Even with a high exchange rate of US Dollar x Brazilian Real, prices remain low, and with a high currency volatility, which keeps the current situation extremely difficult for companies. The month of July registered a reaction of 36.8% in value and 44.1% in volume compared to June. The accumulated exported volume now shows a drop of 16.7% (before 17.9%), while the total value practically did not react, now presenting -28.2% (before -28.8%). As for the leather types, only Crust still has positive levels in volume, with +3.3% (+4.3%). All other types of leather are negative, with Wet Blue and Finished values being the worst results, with -32.6% and -31.4%, respectively. Salted hides, which had already increased significantly until June, increased shipments even further, with an accumulated +32.0% in value and +171.8% in weight. Among the three largest destinations for Brazilian leather, the negative indexes are still apparent, but now Italy also shows improvement compared to June, joining China. This reaction, although slow and timid, can show a change of direction for the rest of the year. -


